**Fancy a change of perspective? –
Then you've come to the right place!**

From Baumwipfelpfad Steigerwald you can experience the forest from a new perspective.

High up in the treetops, our path, built of larch and Douglas fir, winds its way over a length of 1,150 m through Ebracher Forst, rich in deciduous hardwood, in the westernmost part of the district of Bamberg. Our centrepiece and pride and joy is the unique tower that takes you to a height of 42 m above the highest treetops. But don't worry, the whole facility is barrier-free and therefore easily accessible for everyone. Once at the top, you will be rewarded with impressive views over the Steigerwald and the Franconian Plateau. Something very special in every season! Sometimes green, sometimes colourful, sometimes without leaves! Or even snowed in. Our free parking spaces are located directly on the B22. From there, you can reach the ticket office and the entrance to the treetop path after a 5-minute walk through the forest.

EXPERIENCE NATURE & WILDLIFE UP CLOSE

Learn interesting facts about sustainable forest cultivation at the Bayerische Staatsforsten and the forest as a habitat for our native flora and fauna. From the path, you can observe the lively activity of our bird life at the giant bird feeder. The red deer, which are so shy in the wild, can be seen from the trail and give you an insight into their way of life. You can even get up close and personal with the mouflons in their enclosure at the exit.



KUGELPFAD

Our large outdoor marble run “Kugelpfad“ is located at the end of the path at the forest playground. The play stations are constantly being expanded with exciting new elements. The suitable 5 cm baubles made of Steigerwald beech wood are sold on site. By the way: the baubles are made by a family business in the region.

JOINT ACTION FOR THE REGION

The Baumwipfelpfad Steigerwald complements the nearby “Steigerwald-Zentrum – Experience Sustainability”. An idyllic hiking trail connects the two facilities and leads you through the colourful forests of Ebracher Forst to nearby Handthal. You will find a map on the back of this flyer.

Whether you’re very hungry or just a little, there’s something tasty for everyone at the Baumwipfelpfad! The restaurant offers a variety of freshly prepared dishes.
